Explanatory note

This Order is made pursuant to section 165A (2) (a) of the Water Act 1912. The object of this Order is to declare certain works constructed or proposed to be constructed on land or works situated on land that are modified, for the purposes only of complying with a direction given under the State Emergency Services Act 1989 or the State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989 in an emergency, not to be a controlled work for the purposes of the definition in section 165A of the Water Act 1912.

WATER ACT (DECLARATION THAT A WORK IS NOT A PART 8 CONTROLLED WORK) (No. 1) ORDER 2012

1. Name of Order

This Order is the Water Act (Declaration that a work is not a Part 8 controlled work) (No. 1) Order 2012.

2. Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published in the *NSW Government Gazette*.

3. Declaration

(1) A work that:

- (a) is constructed or proposed to be constructed, on land by any person for the purposes only of complying with a direction given under the State Emergency Service Act 1989 or the State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989 in an emergency (within the meaning of the latter Act), or
- (b) is situated on land and is modified by any person for the purposes only of complying with a direction given under the State Emergency Services Act 1989 or the State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989 in an emergency (within the meaning of the latter Act),

is declared not to be a controlled work for the purposes of section 165A (2) (a).

- (2) Subclause (1) (a) only applies if the work is removed within a period of three months from when it was constructed.
- (3) Subclause (1) (b) only applies if the work is restored to its pre-modified state, within a period of three months from the modification occurring.

Note: Under Part 8 of the Act only an occupier of land can apply for an approval to construct a controlled work. However, to comply with a direction under the State Emergency Service Act 1989 or the State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989, it may be necessary for a person other than the occupier of the land to construct a new controlled work or to modify an existing controlled work. Where a new controlled work is constructed or an existing controlled work is modified by a person for the purposes of complying with a direction, the work is taken not to be a controlled work provided the person removes the work or restores the work to its pre-modified state within three months as the case may be.

Sections 8 and 11 Notification – Fishing Closure

Ocean Waters immediately south of the Clarence River, the southern part of Shark Bay (Iluka)
and from Snapper Rock to the Evans River

I, GEOFF ALLAN, Executive Director, Fisheries NSW, with the delegated authority of the Minister for Primary Industries and the Director-General of the Department of Trade and Investment, Regional Infrastructure and Services pursuant to sections 227 and 228 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 (“the Act”), do by this notification:

1. pursuant to section 11 of the Act revoke the fishing closures titled ‘Ocean Waters immediately south of the Clarence River and from Woody Bay to Flat Rock (north of Ballina)’ published in *NSW Government Gazette* No. 29 of 23 March 2012 at page 753, and
2. pursuant to section 8 of the Act prohibit the taking of all species of fish by the method of otter trawl net (prawns) by all endorsement holders in the Ocean Trawl Fishery in the waters described in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notification for the period specified in Column 2 of that Schedule, unless under the direct supervision of an employee of the Department of Primary Industries or otherwise with the consent of the Executive Director, Fisheries NSW for the purpose of undertaking trials to determine the abundance and/or size of fish (including prawns) and informing any decision to amend or revoke this fishing closure.

In this fishing closure:

Endorsement holder has the same meaning as in the Fisheries Management (Ocean Trawl Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006.

Ocean Trawl Fishery means the share management fishery of that name, as described in Schedule 1 to the Act.

The provisions of this fishing closure in respect of endorsement holders in the Ocean Trawl Fishery have effect despite any provisions in the Fisheries Management (Ocean Trawl Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006.

This fishing closure is effective from midday on the date of publication of this notification until 1 July 2012, unless sooner amended or revoked.

Notes:

1. The purpose of this fishing closure is to prohibit the use of prawn trawl nets (i.e. the otter trawl net (prawns)) to take fish because of incidental catches of small prawns and high levels of bycatch, including juvenile mullet.

The Act transfers responsibility for the regulation of on-site plumbing and drainage work from water utilities and local councils to NSW Fair Trading and requires compliance with prescribed standards for plumbing and drainage. A draft Plumbing and Drainage Regulation 2012 is being released for public comment along with a Regulatory Impact Statement so that stakeholders and interested parties can consider the proposed provisions and submit comments.

The primary objective of the proposed draft regulation is to set out the detail needed to enable the Plumbing and

Drainage Act to be effectively administered and to support its objectives of providing for day-to-day operational plumbing matters such as fees, penalties, time periods for lodging notices, exemptions and certificates of compliance.

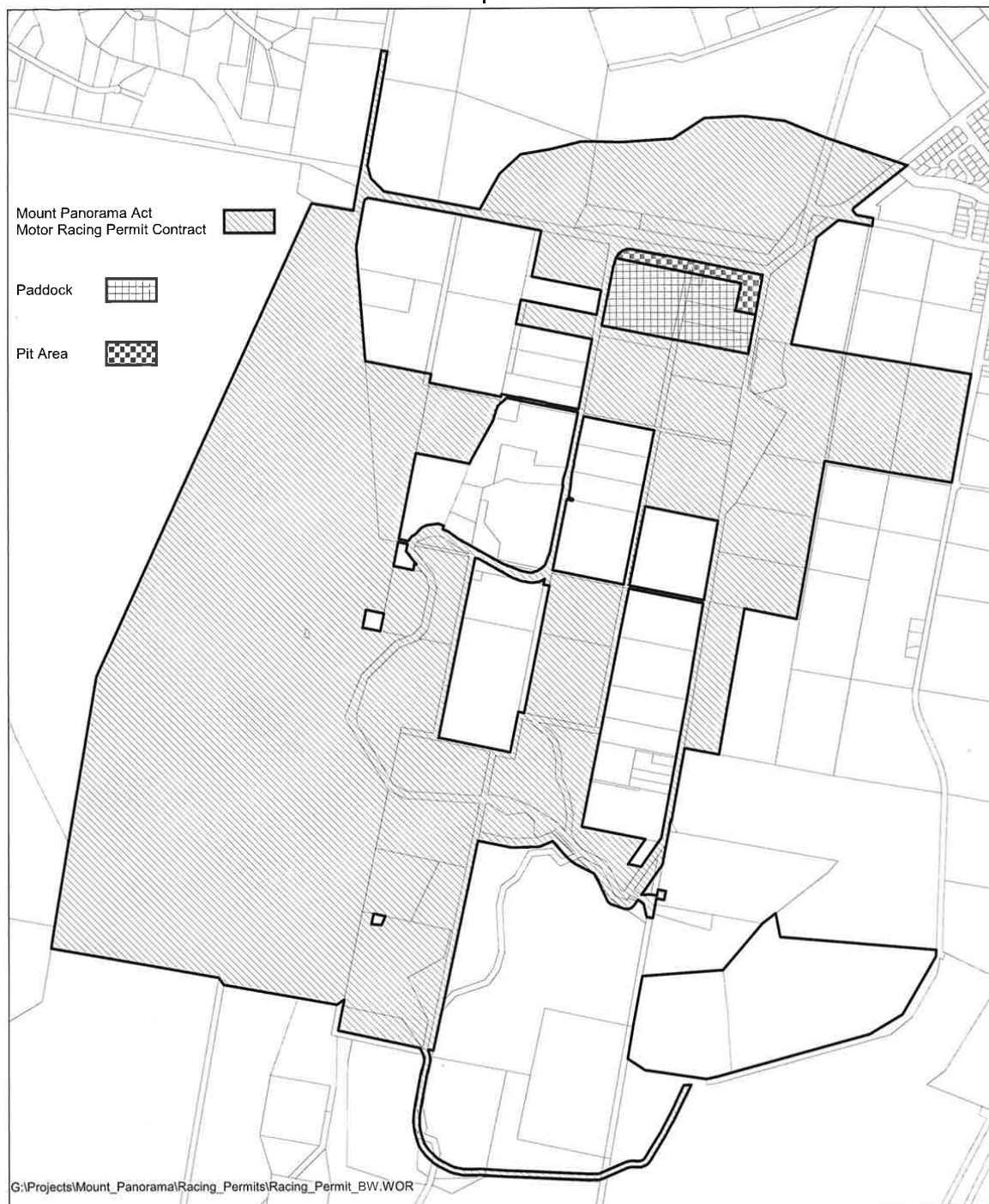
