Instrument of Determination - Total Allowable Catch for Rock Lobster

I, KATRINA ANN HODGKINSON, M.P., Minister for Primary Industries, pursuant to section 33 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 ("the Act"), provide notice that the Total Allowable Catch Setting and Review Committee established under section 26 of the Act:

- 1. pursuant to sections 28 and 33 of the Act revokes the determination titled "Instrument of Determination Total Allowable Catch for Rock Lobster" dated 30 July 2012 and published in *New South Wales Government Gazette* No. 79 of 31 July 2012, at page 3613 and any determination revived as a result of this revocation; and
- 2. pursuant to section 28 of the Act and Clause 14 of the Appendix to the Fisheries Management (Lobster Share Management Plan) Regulation 2000, determines that the total allowable catch for eastern rock lobster for the fishing period beginning 1 August 2013 and ending 31 July 2014 (both dates inclusive), is 150 tonnes.







Opal Cove Rally Headquarters Map


