CABINET COMES TO ALBURY

NSW Premier Barry O'Farrell has announced that Albury has been chosen as the next centre to host a Community Cabinet meeting.

"The people of the Albury electorate put their faith in a NSW Liberals & Nationals Government and this is a strong message to those communities that we will continue to listen," Mr O'Farrell said.

"On Monday 25 June 2012 my Cabinet and I will tour the region - and I encourage you to meet the Ministers who run your roads, schools and hospitals.

"We will also be joined by local member, Greg Aplin, who has been strongly advocating for this meeting to be held in Albury.

"In addition to the Community Cabinet meeting, Ministers will hold pre-arranged meetings with stakeholder and community groups.

"Whether it's supporting jobs, delivering services and infrastructure or tackling the costs of living, the NSW Government is determined to help the Albury region's families and communities meet their potential," Mr O'Farrell said.

Mr Aplin said he was delighted the meeting would be held in the border city, giving the region's communities another say in the decisions affecting them.

"The NSW Government pledged to give Albury a greater say in its future and it's by collaborating that we can best provide the infrastructure and services people expect," Mr Aplin said.
