8.2 <u>LITTLE BARBER STREET – ROAD WIDENING – ACQUISITION OF LAND</u>

4.11/21E COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS:

- 1. That Council endeavour to acquire by agreement the Land identified within Acquisition Plan DP 1274469 Little Barber Street, Gunnedah as Lots 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27 & 29 for road widening purposes under Section 177 of the *Roads Act 1993*;
- 2. That, if agreement is reached, Council agree to pay compensation as outlined in the Valuation Report or following further valuation if required in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991;
- 3. That if no such agreement is reached within a reasonable period of time:
 - a. The acquisition of the Land be carried out by compulsory process in accordance with Part 1 Chapter 8 of the Local Government Act 1993 and the Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991;
 - b. Council seek approval from the Minister for Local Government in accordance with section 187 of the *Local Government Act 1993* to give all necessary Proposed Acquisition Notices in accordance with the *Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991*;
 - c. Council take each further step as is necessary to obtain approval from the Minister, the Governor or any public authority as may be necessary, and take all action as may be necessary, to give notices and otherwise carry out the acquisitions by means of compulsory acquisition;
 - d. Following receipt of the Minister's approval, Council serve each acquisition notice and take each other action necessary to carry out the acquisition;
 - e. Following receipt of the Governor's approval, Council give effect to the acquisition by publication of an Acquisition Notice in the NSW Government Gazette and such other publication as may be required by law;
 - f. Council pay any compensation to all interest holders entitled to compensation by virtue of the compulsory acquisition on the terms set out in the *Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991*.
 - 4. That Council authorise the General Manager to complete and execute all documentation necessary to give effect to this resolution; and
- 5. That upon acquisition, Council will dedicate the Land as Public Road pursuant to Section 10 of the *Roads Act 1993*.
